Flavours of Vercelli

The traditional cuisine, simple and tasty, is a pleasant experience and will know how to satisfy even the most demanding palates. Must try foods in Vercelli: **Panissa**, a rice-based dish with beans, salami and pork rind; **Bicciolani**, fragrant biscuits with scents of cinnamon, cloves and coriander; **Tartufata**, a delicious sponge cake layered with hazelnut and chocolate.

MUST SEE IN Vercelli



1 ABBAZIA DI SANT'ANDREA

One of the first examples of Gothic-Romanesque architecture in Italy. The abbey complex consists also of a splendid cloister and a chapter house of rare beauty.



2 PIAZZA CAVOUR

Heart and economic centre of the city: this charming square is surrounded by stately arcades and dominated by the Torre dell'Angelo.



3 CATTEDRALE DI SANT'EUSEBIO

Vercelli's most imposing church preserves a splendid medieval crucifix and the remains of St. Eusebius.



4 GAUDENZIO FERRARI'S FRESCOES

The masterpieces of art by one of the protagonists of the Piedmontese Renaissance can be found in the Church of San Cristoforo, also known as the "Sistine Chapel of Vercelli".



5 CORSO LIBERTÀ

The main shopping street of Vercelli, lined with centuries old buildings, historic monuments and churches.

MUST DO

1 DISCOVER THE MEDIEVAL TOWN

Ancient religious buildings, fascinating medieval towers and precious artistic masterpieces. During the **Middle Ages**, Vercelli was one of the **most important cities in northern Italy** and still preserves evidence of its glorious past in the urban fabric and its museums.

2 ENJOY A DELICIOUS RISOTTO

The true king of the Vercelli's cuisine is rice, so you can't leave the city without trying a **delicious risotto**. We recommend our traditional dish, **panissa**, although you'll be spoilt for choice.

3 EXPLORE THE LANDS OF RICE

Vercelli is completely surrounded by **rice fields** dotted with ancient farmhouses and charming villages rich in tradition. In spring, when the rice paddies are flooded, the landscape shows us its most spectacular views: the **'checked sea'**.
