

From Scopello, the best place for a family vacation, it is easy to reach Alpe di Mera, a charming and sunny destination with a fantastic view of Monte Rosa. The area between Scopello and Mera offers countless opportunities for outdoor activities in any season: from trekking and water sports in summer to snowshoeing and skiing in winter.



The town preserves in the urban fabric many traces of its glorious past such as the maiestic Parish Church of San Giacomo, one of the most beautiful churches in Valsesia, and historic buildings on both sides of the Sesia River. From the village, Alpe dell'Argnaccia can be reached via the enchanting art trail: an itinerary dotted with ancient chapels, shrines and oratories.
